Dear parents/carers,

It has been a long half term and the children are definitely ready for a break... as are the staff!

This week there were a couple of school trips. Thankfully the farm visit which had to be postponed last week due to bad weather went ahead today and the children in Year 2 had an amazing time. Thank you for your understanding when the farm postponed the original trip... as a working farm they don't have the facilities to accommodate the children safely when the rain is so heavy, but it was certainly worth the wait!

The children return to school on <u>Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> November</u> as Monday 6<sup>th</sup> is our annual MAC INSET Day where all staff across our five academies join together for training and the celebration of mass at St Thomas More Catholic Academy in Longton. We celebrate this together at this time of year as 1<sup>st</sup> November each year is dedicated to the feast of All Saints. Therefore, as the All Saints Catholic Collegiate, we mark this occasion together.

The month of November is traditionally where the Catholic community remembers those who have died. Churches ask parishioners to bring the names of those who have passed away to services so that prayers can be said for them. In school, we will be remembering those who have died in our class and whole school prayer sessions, so we encourage the children to bring

photos of anyone they would like included in these prayers into school.

During the week of 13<sup>th</sup> November, we will be visited by Rise Theatre who will be spending the day in school working with the children to produce a performance which is based on God the Creator (Genesis 1).

The interactive show helps the children to explore and discover the awe and beauty in God's creation and how we are a part of God's beautiful creation - fearfully and wonderfully made!

The theatre company will be giving children the opportunity to buy a 'Planet Hero' badge which will help the children to remember the important messages from the day. If you would like your child to buy one, please make sure they bring £1 into school on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> November.
