

**Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> February is Ash Wednesday – the day that marks the start of the season of Lent.** The information below explains the tradition. When the children return to school for the new half term, they will be learning about Lent and taking part in liturgies which focus on the themes of prayer, fasting and works of charity. On Monday 19<sup>th</sup> February, our assembly will be led by Cafod who will be sharing some information about 'The Big Lent Walk' – information will be sent out to parents about how you can get involved in this event with your children.



Ashes were worn by people in the Old Testament to show their repentance (Jonah 3).  
We also wear ashes on Ash Wednesday as a sign of our repentance and grief for our sins.



The ashes come from the blessed palms used in the Palm Sunday celebration of the previous year.
